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1 – 1st XI 2007

1.1– Season’s Report

The 2007 season will not be one that will linger in the memory for too long and, sadly, that will be the form for the reports that accompany the statistics that are to be found in this season’s Record Book.

The consistently poor weather saw that a true run of matches was never forthcoming and this disjointed structure to the season ran through all four senior sides.

The 1st XI suffered a drop of one place from their 2006 SCL Division One finish from fourth to fifth and in a season of matches decimated by the elements it is hard to gauge whether the final table reflects the true order of the division – there was no doubt that Wembdon and Chew Magna were the best two sides, but after that, basement outfit Evercreech apart, only 83 points separated us and relegated Wedmore in ninth place.

Continuity of selection was a watchword for the season just gone and, sadly, there was just not enough of it to go round the two league XIs as the line-ups settled upon were continually in a state of flux up to and including match day itself sometimes – this affected the 2nd XI more than the 1st XI, but the net effect was felt by both sides and with this been the case progress will be hard to come by.

Even though I write with some level of dudgeon there were positives to come out of a difficult season – the form of our overseas player David Marshall with the ball was outstanding bearing in mind that he took 40 wickets in only 15 games, this was the best season’s return for the team in this respect for a decade.

Kevin Symons gave him good support with a haul of 25 wickets in 14 matches.

The team’s batting was unspectacular with only 8 half-centuries been recorded all season and no score of more than 80 been posted by any individual batsman.

The quality of the playing surface on offer at home matches was questionable and the poor weather not only affected match days, but practice sessions too and this may well explain the batting statistics returned overall with only Mark Salter making over 350 runs in the season just passed.

As the season wore on older junior players were integrated into the league XIs and this will be a cornerstone policy for 2008 – if this can be combined with more concentrated availability from the core senior players then this could be the base to achieve promotion to the Somerset Division of the WEPL – this is the standard that we need to be playing at and with Division One of the SCL becoming more and more rural with each passing season this is a level that we need to get to sooner rather than later.

(a) – The SCL was formed in 1973. Wellington 1st XI joined in 1974.

(b) – The SCL removed the title of ‘Premier Division’ in the 1993 close season and thus all divisions were downgraded by one, so that the old Division One (which the 1st XI were in) became the new Division Two. These changes took effect from the start of the 1994 season.

(c) – Despite finishing in a relegation position in 1995, the 1st XI retained their Division Two status because of the withdrawal of Uphill Castle and Claverton in the 1995 close season. Both these teams left Division One, which meant that no teams were relegated from that division and consequentially none from Division Two either. The only movement of teams was that of Watchet and Ilminster from Division Two to Division One and that of Lydford and Whitchurch from Division Three to Division Two.

(d) – Due to the formation of the WECCC in 1999 the SCL underwent another re-organisation of the 1st XI competition. This change meant that the 1st XI was in Division One from the 2000 season.

(e) – Despite finishing in a relegation position in 2001 the 1st XI retained their WECCC status because of geographical anomalies in other parts of the ‘pyramid’ structure. The only movement of teams was that of Westlands upwards to the Western Alliance by virtue of their winning of the WECCC (Somerset) division and that of Winscombe to replace Westlands by virtue of their winning of the SCL.

2 – 2nd XI 2007

2.1 – Season's Report

That the 2nd XI stayed up comfortably in the end was a marvellous achievement anyway, as consolidation after any promotion season has to be the aim, but against a backdrop of the variable and testing availability patterns that lasted all season to be able to report this as an end result is very pleasing.

The season saw some twenty-nine players used in total and, although I comment on availability in both the 1st XI and this report, this is perhaps not as large a number of personnel used as may have been predicted.

The hardest times were the first two matches in June when getting hold of eleven players who had some knowledge of the game took until match day itself – it is not surprising that the matches in this period (away to Taunton St Andrews and home to Street) saw us lose by 145 runs and nine wickets respectively.

Three wins from the four home matches played that survived the weather between the Street defeat and Winscombe been washed out for the second time in the season were what pretty much kept us up and the icing on the cake of survival was the pulsating run chase at Staplegrove when Chris Rudd and Julian Jones chased down 243 to win.

James Dyke and Kevin Crout deserve much praise for keeping the team going when times were hard and for seeing that our status at this level – we fought hard to achieve it in 2006 – was retained. It would have been easy to lose heart at times, but they kept going.

Chris Rudd starred with the bat and took the batting award with the best haul of league runs across the two teams – he hit three half-centuries, his best offering been 91no against Staplegrove.

Julian Jones deserves special mention for his 141no in the same game when everything he hit seemed to find the boundary.

The rest of the batting was solid with Kevin Crout combining opening the batting and keeping wicket effectively as a haul of 222 runs and eleven dismissals shows.

The bowling was again, statistically at least, the stronger part of the team's game with Richard Henwood and Martin Short forming an effective opening partnership as their combination of right and left arm bowling showed. Richard's hat-trick against TSA brightened an otherwise poor day for us.

Bob Trott was the other bowler who qualified for the bowling award this season and he has lost none of his accuracy as another campaign passes.

Other players who represented the team performed well with Richard Henwood and James Dyke each contributing over 150 runs each.

Once again it is worth reminding ourselves of what could have been achieved with more settled league sides in 2007 and there are lessons to learn for the 2008 campaigns, but with some heeding of these and the right amount of planning in the close season where it is needed we can achieve what we want to next time round.

4.1 – Season's Report

In contrast to the travails that the Saturday league XIs endured at times, the Sunday XI had a wonderful season with many good things to report.

Only two matches were lost all season (and arguably these could have been won) and the side was unbeaten in league competition all season, but could only finish fourth as weather robbed us of two good winning opportunities – had we been able to close just one of them out we would have been champions for sure as Weymouth only took the title by fourteen points from us.

I have to start this review of the season by commending Rob Moysey on a season when he was absolutely outstanding with the bat and effective with the ball – he hit well over 1000 runs and recorded seven fifties and four hundreds, only two of his scores for the side were under 50 as he batted supremely throughout the Sunday XI season. Naturally he took the batting award by a wide margin.

He took the bowling award on the back of his 7-21 against Taunton St Andrews, pipping Phil Nicholls by the slim margin of 0.27 runs per wicket.

Phil had bowled well all season as he bowled with pace and accuracy as he reprised his bowling style after suffering with back problems the previous season.

He was a great spearhead to have at one's disposal – a hat trick against Mallards swung a tight game our way.

David Marshall got through the heaviest workload on a Sunday and a return of 25 wickets was a good haul and in other seasons his average of 12.60 would have seen him finish higher than third in this category.

His batting was good enough to record 423 runs and take second place.

James Dyke with 303 runs had a productive Sunday XI season and played a number of pleasing knocks.

It was pleasing to be able to integrate youth players such as Josh Hancock, James Webber, Jake Nicol and Matt Weaver into the team and they were given opportunities to perform with both bat and ball and did not disappoint.

To lose by two runs at Weymouth when we had the game in the bag was the only real disappointment on the field of play all season.

As previously mentioned the Three Counties League season saw us maintain an unbeaten record, but only finish fourth as the weather deprived us of completing matches with Dorchester and Axminster.

Thom Trott ran the side well, despite been blighted with knee problems later in the season – these saw me take over for two matches.

With potential for some new and exciting fixtures in 2008 the prospects for the Sunday XI are good, despite the withdrawal of the league sponsors it will continue to run, even if the competing clubs run it as a cooperative.

The Midweek XI was well run by Andy Perry and in a wet season this team suffered more than the other three senior sides with three of eight matches scheduled falling victim to cancellations.

The cancellation before match day of some others left a hole in the team's fixture list even before the weather got involved, but interest in playing the mixture of 20/20 and all-afternoon matches was good and there were no issues with raising teams.

I will look to expand the all-afternoon component of this team's schedule in 2008 through advertising WCC as an ideal venue for touring sides – 20/20 will also be an important part of the set-up too.

So in a season when the weather and other matters made for a not-totally memorable campaign, the friendly XIs provided a ray of sunshine.
